KARIGON'S NEW LOBBY



Karigon Safety Reminders

Safety remains a top priority here at Kargon and as such we ask that you please review the following safety reminders regarding Morning Drop Off procedures:

- Students being dropped off should remain in the vehicle until 7:50 a.m.
- Please consider which lane you enter the bus loop in. Please use the right lane for turning right and left lane for turning left after student drop off. This will ensure a smooth transition for everyone.
- Please remain in your vehicle and let your child exit on the right side of your car when possible.
- Please refrain from walking students to the door or down the sidewalks while in the drop off lane. If you would like to do this, please park your car in the Karigon/Orenda lot.
- Please do not pull in the bus lane when buses are parked there. After 7:55, proceed to drop off lanes in the parking lot.
- After dropping off your student in the parking lot, please do not drive through empty parking spots as other cars or pedestrians can be in your blind spot.

Please note that students who bring their cell phones or smart watches to school will be asked to either leave their device in their book bag or give it to their teacher to hold.


All meetings begin at 6:30 pm in the Karigon Library
